REGULATION OF International Intellectual Games Tournament in Toguz Korgool and Oware – Poland Open 2019.

1. GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

- Popularization of intellectual games Toguz Korgool and Oware in international arena.
- Strengthening and developing intercultural dialogue, friendship, and cooperation among the nations of the world.
- Identification of the strongest athletes in Toguz Korgool and Oware.

2. MANAGEMENT AND ORGANIZATION

The general management of the organization and conducting of the International Intellectual Games Tournament in Toguz Korgool and Oware, in discipline Rapid, is carried out by the organizing committee approved by the International Federation of Mancala Games and the Polish Sport Club of Toguz Korgool.

6. GAME CONDITIONS AND AWARDDING

Suitable for players of all ages and ability. There are 7 rounds of the Swiss system. In a case of Toguz Korgool 1 round=50 minutes, 25 minutes for each player. Owari tournament's 1 round=40 minutes, 20 minutes for each player.

The winning player scores 1 point, for a draw – 0.5 points, the loser player does not count points. Winners are determined by the number of points. If the points are equal, then the “progress” ratio is considered. With the same "progress" coefficient, the "Buchholz" coefficient is taken into account. With the same "Buchholz" coefficient, the result of personal meetings is considered. In the case of a tie, dialed korgools in lost games are taken into account: whoever has the most korgools, will have an advantage.

Only the best results of 2 players 1 male and 1 female from one country will be taken into account. Winners will be awarded with diplomas, medals and souvenirs. The number of prizes is from 3 to 9, depending on the number of countries. The maximum number of prizes with the participation of at least 5 countries. Players who attend both tournaments will be awarded with certificates of attendance.

7. ACCOMODATION INFO:

Rooms with a higher standard (breakfast included in the cost of the hotel day), in the following rooms (1 EUR=4,3 PLN):

- single room (130 PLN per day)
- double room (180 PLN per day / room)
- small 2-person apartment (PLN 200 per day / room);

Student rooms (shared bathroom for 2 rooms), kitchen on the floor:

- 1-bed room (54 PLN per day)

ATTENTION! Please note that number of rooms are limited.

8. PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION:

Public transportation: from Jowita Student House (Kaponiera stop) to Poland Open Venue (last stop Sobieskiego) is connected by tram (numbers 12, 14, 15, 16). It takes about 12 min, totally 6 stops.

Tram Tickets

Single-journey time ticket by tram: 10-minute costs 3 PLN, 40-minute 4.6 PLN (more than 1 euro)

Short-term tickets include the following types:

- 24-hour (1 day) ticket which costs 13.6 PLN
- 48-hour (2-days) ticket which costs 21 PLN
- 72-hour (3-days) ticket which costs 27 PLN

RECOMMEND: 24-hour ticket validated between 8:00 p.m. or later on Friday and 12:00 a.m. on Saturday entitles a passenger to travel up to 12:00 a.m. on Sunday

2 validated 24-hour tickets (normal price) entitle to ride on ZTM lines by 2 adults and up to 3 children (not older than 15-years old)
